ABVP: Akhil Bhartiya Vidhyarthi Parishad

Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad is a right-wing all India student organisation affiliated to the RSS

Purpose of ABVP:

AISA: All India Students' Association

All India Students' Association is a left wing student organisation in India. It describes itself as "the voice of the radical students' movement" and is affiliated to the Communist Party of India Liberation

Purpose of AISA:

Feeling the need to defeat the forces of far right communal fascism, and conservative neo-liberalism, and to fulfill the task of building a pan-India radical students' movement so as to not only win the struggle for students' rights, but also to channel the energy of country's youth into the task of nation building on progressive lines.

Impact of AISA:

AISA has launched many campaigns like Right to accomodation, Protest against Youth Loan Education Model, Protest against Agri bills. AISA has led the struggle for a radical surge of education, culture, society and politics.
